ALF Call for Proposals 2006: Summary Report (last update: 28.01.07)

In the framework of enhancing understanding between cultures and exchanges between civil societies in the Euro-Mediterranean region, the Anna Lindh Euro-Mediterranean Foundation for the Dialogue between Cultures launched in 2006 its first Call For Proposals (ALF/2006/CFP − revolving CFP with three deadlines a year) and allocated 1.500.000 € for funding projects submitted to the Foundation.

The total costs of the 40 projects selected in the first, second and third rounds of the ALF CFP is 3.080.762,3 €.

The ALF contributes to the 40 projects by granting $1.353.760 \in (43.9\%)$, thus mobilizing another 1.727.002,3 Euro from other sources..

The 40 grants were awarded to **191 institutions and organizations from 31 out of the 35 EuroMed countries** (see table attached). 91 project partners come from Mediterranean Partner countries, 100 from EU countries. **Conclusion: The 2+2 formula applied by the Foundation is a very efficient vehicle for promoting the objective of "equal partnership between North and South".**

The 6 thematic priorities approved by the ALF Board of Governors for 2006 are: [in brackets: number of approved grant contracts; one is in two categories, total 41]

- o Theme A: EuroMed music and other cultural/artistic creation; [16]
- o Theme B: EuroMed schools programme; [6]
- o Theme C: EuroMed teams of young researchers; [3]
- o Theme D: Summer schools/exchange programmes(artists in residence);[7]
- o Theme E: Libraries, promotion of books and reading, translation; [1]
- o Theme F: Intercultural exchanges for women in civil society organizations. [7]

In the framework of the ALF CFP 2006 first round:

- 17 proposals were submitted (15 before the deadline and 2 after).
- 9 proposals (7 from EU member States and 2 from Mediterranean partners) passed the first phase of the evaluation process (screening of Administrative compliance and Eligibility).
- 7 projects were recommended for granting by Evaluation Committee after the second phase of the evaluation process (quality assessment); the Executive

- Director of the Foundation approved the recommendations \Rightarrow 7 contracts (2 with applicants from Mediterranean Partner Countries and 5 with applicants from EU Member States)
- The total amount granted after contract negotiation is 241.760 € (equivalent to 40.5% of the total cost of the 7 projects).
- 15 Euro-Mediterranean civil society organizations submitted proposals to the Foundation before the deadline: 3 proposals were submitted by civil society organizations from the EU Mediterranean Partners and 12 from civil society organizations from the EU Member States.
- 35 Euro-Mediterranean civil society organizations (18 from the Mediterranean Partners and 17 from the EU member States) were involved (as leader or partner) in the 7 projects granted by the ALF
- 2 grant contracts were signed for projects under Theme A "EuroMed music and other cultural/artistic creation", 3 for Theme B "EuroMed schools programme" and 2 for Theme D "Summer schools/exchange programmes (artists in residence)".

In the framework of the ALF CFP2006 second round:

- 47 proposals were submitted to the Foundation (44 before the deadline and 3 after).
- 29 proposals (7 from organizations of the Mediterranean Partner Countries and 22 from organizations of the EU Member States) passed the first phase of the evaluation process.
- 19 projects were recommended for granting by Evaluation Committee after second phase of evaluation process (quality assessment); the Executive Director of the Foundation approved the recommendations and decided to add 2 projects to the short-list ⇒ 21 contracts (7 with org. from Mediterranean Partner Countries and 14 with org. from EU Member States).
- Total amount granted before contract signature (negotiation is on-going) is 702.241 € (equivalent to 43% of the total cost of the 21 projects).
- 44 Euro-Mediterranean civil society organizations submitted proposals to the Foundation before the deadline. 15 proposals were submitted by civil society organizations from the EU Mediterranean Partners and 29 from civil society organizations from the EU member States.
- 97 Euro-Mediterranean civil society organizations (43 from the Mediterranean Partners and 54 from the EU member States) were involved (as leader or partner) in the 21 projects granted by the ALF
- Out of the 44 proposals received, granting of 21 projects was approved 11 projects cover Theme A "EuroMed music and other cultural/artistic creation", 2 for Theme B "EuroMed schools programme", 2 for Theme C "EuroMed teams of young researchers", 3 for Theme D "Summer schools/exchange programmes (artists in residence)", 1 for Theme E "Libraries, promotion of books and reading, translation" and 2 for Theme F "Intercultural exchanges for women in civil society organizations".

In the framework of the ALF CFP2006 third round:

- 42 proposals were submitted to the Foundation (37 before the deadline and 5 after).
- 23 proposals (4 from organizations of the Mediterranean Partner Countries and 19 from organizations of the EU Member States) passed the first phase of the evaluation process.
- 11 projects were recommended for granting by Evaluation Committee after second phase of evaluation process (quality assessment); the Executive Director of the Foundation approved the recommendations and decided to add 1 project to the short-list ⇒ 12 contracts (2 with org. from Mediterranean Partner Countries and 10 with org. from EU Member States).
- Total amount granted before contract signature (negotiation is on-going) is 409.753 € (equivalent to 48.6% of the total cost of the 12 projects).
- 37 Euro-Mediterranean civil society organizations submitted proposals to the Foundation before the deadline. 7 proposals were submitted by civil society organizations from the EU Mediterranean Partners and 30 from civil society organizations from the EU Member States.
- 59 Euro-Mediterranean civil society organizations (29 from the Mediterranean Partners and 30 from the EU member States) were involved (as leader or partner) in the 12 projects granted by the ALF.
- Out of the 37 proposals received, granting of 12 projects was approved.
- 3 projects cover Theme A "EuroMed music and other cultural/artistic creation", 1 for Theme B "EuroMed schools programme", 1 for Theme C "EuroMed teams of young researchers", 2 for Theme D "Summer schools/exchange programmes (artists in residence)", and 5 for Theme F "Intercultural exchanges for women in civil society organizations".
